Itinerary

Day 1: Tbilisi-Ananuri-Truso-Gergeti-Kazbegi

Driving: 178 km, approx. 4 h 30 min.

Hiking:

- a) **Truso Valley**: 6.0 km, ↑ 214 m, ↓ 95 m
- b) Gergeti Trinity: 5.0 km, ↕ 377 m.

9:00 AM - drive to North, towards **Kazbegi** (aka **Stepantsminda**). Pass by **Ananuri Fortress**, village **Kobi** and enter into beautiful **Truso Valley** for “warm up” trek, reaching the ruins of **Zakagori castle** near border area. Stop by Abano bubbling lake and several travertines spread throughout the valley.

After the hike – drive to **Kazbegi** town, check in hotel and take a short hike to **Gergeti Trinity Church** (5 km roundtrip, 377 m elevation gain/drop).

Overnight in **Kazbegi**.

Day 2: Kazbegi - Gergeti - Sabertse Pass - Kazbegi

Driving: 6 km, approx. 30 min.

Hiking: 8.0 km, ⬆ 775 m.

In the morning drive up to **Gergeti** campsite near the **Trinity Church** and take a hike in direction of **Kazbegi** mountain, reaching Sabertse Pass (3100 m.). In good weather the pass offers spectacular panoramic views of the area and nearby glacier. Continue walking a bit further down where you can have lunch and a hot tea in Altihut – alpine basecamp at elevation of 3014 asl (not included). Walk back to [Stepantsminda](#).

Overnight at **Kazbegi**.

Day 3: Kazbegi - Juta - Chaukhi Mountains - Tbilisi

Driving: 183 km, approx. 4 hours.

Hiking: 10 km, ↕ 572 m.

Early morning drive to [Sno](#) Canyon to highest mountain village in the area **Juta** (2250m). Take a hike to **Juta** lake at the base of [Chaukhi Mountain](#), 10 km round trip 3-4 hours.

Drive back to **Tbilisi**.
