Itinerary Day 1: Arrival in Tbilisi

Arrival in Tbilisi airport, pick up and meet your guide at Tbilisi airport.

Overnight in Tbilisi hotel.

Day 2: Free day in Tbilisi

The suggested time to start the tour is 10:00 AM.

After Breakfast at the hotel start the exploration of the capital of Georgia - Tbilisi. Start from Narikala Fortress which you can reach by cable car. Narikala Fortress dates back to 4th century AD, it has a superb location with magnificent panoramic views over the Tbilisi city.

Stroll down to Legvta**Khevi** – a beautiful place wita h waterfall. Take a walk in park near Sulfur bathhouses, well-known for their healing powers Shardeni street and its neighborhood and Meidan square with its outdoor cafes, galleries and souvenir shops.

In the evening head to Mtatsminda funicular tram and ride up to Mtatsminda park and take a relaxing walk in the park

Day 3: Tbilisi - Gremi- Tsinandali-Telavi

Approx. driving distance: 2 hr 43 min (149 km)

First place to visit is **Gremi** Monastery is a 16th-century architectural monument located in the **Kakheti** region of Georgia. The complex includes the Church of the Archangels, which served as the royal chapel for King Levan of **Kakheti**, as well as a bell tower and other buildings. The church is known for its intricate stone carvings andfrescoes. It is a popular tourist destination and isconsidered an important example of medieval Georgianarchitecture.

After **Gremi** drive to Tsinandali estate and visited museum. Tsinandali residence which is a 19th century **Kakheti**an nobleman, public figure and poet as well. The house hasball room, winery, Wooden balcony, there are mixed styleof different countries like English-French garden wherealways held some exhibitions, international classic, wineforums and atc. Also in Tsinandali have taste one glasswhite wine.

After <u>Gremi</u> drive to Tsinandali Estate is a 19th-century complex located in the <u>Kakheti</u> region of Georgia. It is the former residence of Prince Alexander Chavchavadze, a <u>Kakheti</u>an nobleman, public figure, and poet. The estate includes a palace, a winery, a wooden balcony, and an English-French garden. You can tour the palace, which features a ballroom and other elegant rooms, as well as the winery and gardens. In the Tsinandali Estate, there is awine museum showcasing the history of winemaking inGeorgia. The estate also hosts various exhibitions, international classic music events, wine forums, andtastings. Visitors can also taste a glass of the local whitewine produced in the winery. The estate is a popular touristdestination, showcasing the cultural heritage and history ofGeorgia.

Optional: After Tsinandali you have optional activity to visit **Shumi Winery** next to the Tsinandali estate, **Shumi Winery** is a popular winery located in the **Kakheti** region of Georgia. It is known for producing high-quality wines using traditional Georgian wine-making techniques. The

Day 4: Telavi- Kazbegi

Approx. driving distance: 3 hr 40 min (181 km)

After breakfast drive from <u>Telavi</u> to Kazbegi, Via <u>Akhmeta</u> road and you may visit here Kvetera monastery.

Kvetera Monastery is a medieval Georgian Orthodox monastery located in the Kazbegi region of Georgia. It is believed to have been founded in the 9th century and has been an important religious and cultural center for centuries.

After drive to Ananuri Fortress and Zhinvali Reservoir.

Ananuri Fortress is a 17th-century architectural complex located in the Kazbegi region of Georgia. It includes the residential buildings of the Aragvi Dukes and served as a fortification to control the trade route and protect against invasions from the north. The complex is a popular tourist destination, known for its well-preserved towers, churches, and defensive walls. Visitors can explore the fortress and learn about its history and significance. Also you can visit Zhinvali Reservoir is a man-made lake located near Ananuri Fortress.

Next site to visit is **Gudauri** viewpoint, this is the popular spot for tourists. The viewpoint offers a spectacular panoramic view of the surrounding mountains and walleys, you can take a photos and enjoys the beautiful scenery.

Drive to **Stepantsminda**

Overnight in **Stepantsminda** guesthouse.

Day 5: Kazbegi free day

Have breakfast in the morning at the guesthouse.

And that's not all, you can also take a scenic drive to Gveleti waterfall and take a walk to the waterfall, before heading to **Dariali Gorge** and visiting the historic **Dariali Monastery**, The church is also important for religious rituals and belief.

End the day by driving back to **Stepantsminda**, making memories that'll last a lifetime."

Day 6: Kazbegi-Gori-Ateni

Approx. driving distance: 3 hr 30 min (196 km)

After visiting Upistikhe, continue your journey towards Ateni. The route will take you through the picturesque Georgian countryside, with views of rolling hills and green valleys. You'll pass by small villages and traditional Georgian architecture.

Finally, you will reach Ateni, a small village located in the Kaspi municipality. Visit Nika Vacheishvili guesthouse, where you can taste wine and have a dinner.

After breakfast From Ateni, drive towards Borjomi, a small town in the <u>Samtskhe-Javakheti</u> region of Georgia. Borjomi is known for its mineral water, which is sourced from the nearby <u>Borjomi-Kharagauli National Park</u>. Visitors can take a stroll around the town, taste the famous mineral water.

After visiting Borjomi, head towards Atskuri. Along the way, you have the option to make a stop for lunch and wine tasting at Davit Mumladze's winery. The winery produces high-quality wines and visitors can learn about the winemaking process and taste the different varieties of wines. Here, you will have the opportunity to taste as well as savor the traditional Georgian dish of snails.

As you leave Atskuri, you have an option to make a stop at the **Sapara Monastery**. The monastery is a medieval Georgian Orthodox monastery and is considered an important historical and cultural monument. Visitors can explore the monastery, learn about its history and significance and also take in the beautiful views of the surrounding landscapes.

The pedestrian trail is 4.1 km, and this km goes to Mtavarangelozi Mountain. The road goes to the red beach, forest, mountain springs and its end Mtavarangelozi Mountain.

Note: In order to visit Mtavarangelozi Mountain you should go through **Machakhela National Park**'s Visitor Centre.

Drive back to Batumi
